Checklist for Starting A Business

- 1. What is the official name of your business? Remember specialized names may help or hinder you.
- 2. Start small. How small can you get your idea to do the most you can more quickly?
- 3. Have you connected with the Small Business Development Center and/or Small Business Administration? (<u>http://sba.gov</u>)
- 4. Do you have a functioning and active team?
- 5. Are you attending the Chamber of Commerce councils? (Normally, you don't have to join to attend)
- 6. Do you possess the following?
 - Articles of Organization
 - Operating Agreement/Corporate By-Laws
 - Federal Employer Identification Number _____
 - Any necessary business licenses _____
 - Any leases, contracts, or other arrangements which you have regarding your present equipment, office premises, furniture, etc. _____
 - Any insurance information on your business ____
- Does your business do retail sales, leases, or rentals of any goods, computer software, warranty contracts, or certain services and amusements? _____ If so, have you registered with Tennessee Department of Revenue to file the Sales and Use Tax? _____
- 8. If you are a business on which the Gross Receipts Taxes are imposed (bottlers, utilities, vending, and mixing bar setups), have you registered?
- 9. Have you registered for and paid the Franchise and Excise Taxes?
- 10. Have you registered for and paid the Tennessee Business Tax? Have you registered for and paid any municipal business tax which may apply?
- 11. If you are an employer, do you have worker's compensation insurance?
- 12. Does your business use a fictitious name (i.e. a name different from the one on your Articles of Organization)?_____If so, have you properly notified the state of Tennessee?_____
- 13. Do all listings, letterheads, signage, and other materials reflect your official business name?
- 14. Do all leases and contracts reflect your official business name?
- 15. Has any ownership interest of your business been offered or sold since formation? _____ If so, did you consult with an attorney regarding possible tax and/or securities law ramifications? _____
